A **Telecommunications Right-of-Way Use Authorization Agreement** is required for any telecommunications carrier or provider using the public right-of-way to provide telecommunications services to persons or areas <u>outside</u> the City. An application is complete when it is accompanied by the following items. Additional information may be required. APPLICANT ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

I have read, reviewed and understand the conditions stated below and I am familiar with Title 4 of the Brier Municipal Code regarding Telecommunications Right-of-Way Use Authorizations. Initials A Telecommunications Right-of-Way Use Authorization is valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance. Renewal of the Telecommunications Authorization may be granted pursuant to Brier Municipal Code 4.04.130. A separate Telecommunications Right-of-Way Use / Street Opening Permit is required for any work, construction, development, excavation, or installation of any equipment or facilities within the public right-of-way or on city property. It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all applicable codes are complied with and that all contractors and subcontractors are licensed to do work in the State of Washington and the City of Brier. No cutting of fully improved streets or sidewalks is allowed without prior approval from the City of Brier. A new application is required for any work not included in the original authorization. Whenever a new street is accepted from a developer or a new overlay is completed, a five (5) year moratorium on pavement excavation and trenching goes into effect. This could result in delaying further construction of utilities except in the event of an emergency. Exception: Should a new street or new overlay be excavated or trenched, a full or partial street-width overlay will be required, regardless of the pavement area disturbed. All existing pavement shall receive a two (2) inch grinding prior to the overlay. All overlays shall extend ten (10) feet beyond the edge of the trench.
